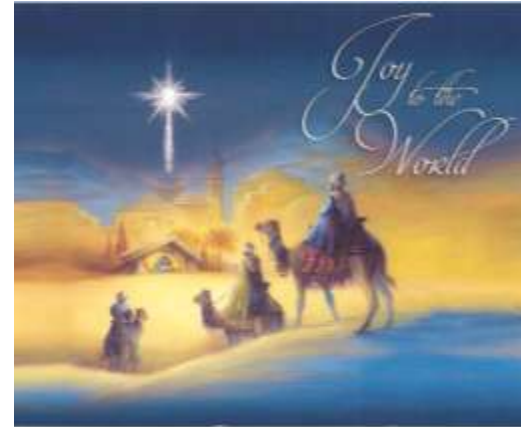

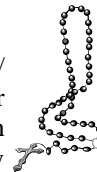


Please God, Forgive Us
