Diocesan Pledge Campaign

Although this is the usual time for our **Idaho Catholic Appeal**, it is not being conducted in 2013 in its usual format. The decision was made to incorporate the 2013 ICA into the campaign goal. **ICA will return during its normal timeframe in 2014. This means there will be no separate solicitation for the 2013 ICA.**

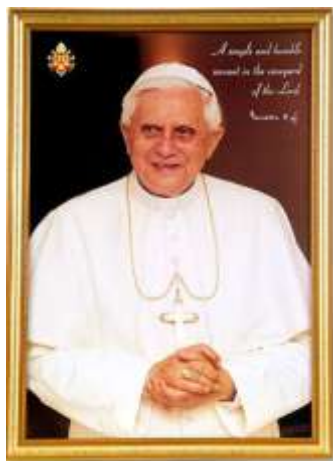
