Parents of Babies/Children Needing Baptism We have been really blessed with many children being born in our community. To simplify the preparation process:

1. If parents are in need of baptism for their child, please come to the parish office and pick up our **records information sheet and guidelines sheet**.
2. You will then schedule the Baptismal Class (for parents and godparents). Father will be offering Baptismal Classes roughly once a month AFTER Saturday evening Mass in the Pentecost room.
3. If coming from outside SPP Parish, a letter from the pastor in your parish confirming that Baptism classes have been taken by the parents and the sponsors is required.

Camas Prairie Food Bank

The majority of the food comes from the Idaho Foods Partnership and the government commodities. It has been arranged to haul in one trip once a month around 12,000 pounds of food. The expenses on hauling this food from Lewiston is about \$250 per month, gas, rent, insurance for a U-haul. If someone is going to spend monies on the purchase of food for the food bank, they would consider donating those funds to help pay for the hauling of the food from Lewiston each month. Checks could be made out to the *Camas Prairie Food Bank* with the memo line stating it is directed to the *"hauling of food"*. you can mail your donation to: 411 E.
