Babies/Children Needing Baptism

We have been really blessed with many children being born in our community. To simplify the preparation process:

1. If parents are in need of baptism for their child, please come to the parish office and pick up our **records information sheet and guidelines sheet**.
2. You will then schedule the Baptismal Class (for parents and godparents). Father will be offering Baptismal Classes roughly once a month AFTER Saturday evening Mass in the Pentecost room.
3. If coming from outside SPP Parish, a letter from the pastor in your parish confirming that Baptism classes have been taken by the parents and the sponsors is required.

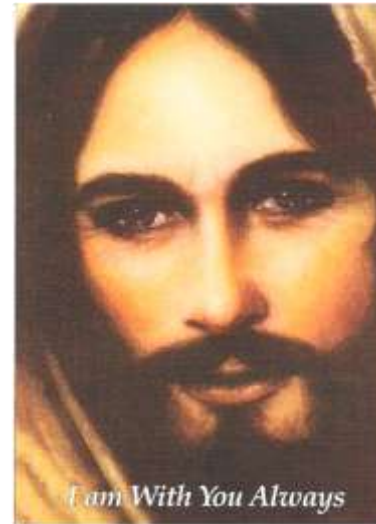

“Net” Income

....for this year’s Rodeo work for four days was \$8059. The Knights anticipate that if we keep committing to running the booths each year we will eventually need to purchase some freezers and refrigerators so we voted to set aside \$1,500 from this years profits to start a fund for those purchases. The remaining \$6,559 was dispersed as follows:

- \$2000 to the Parish.
 - \$2000 to the School which also earned an additional \$750 through the home and school for cleaning the grounds each day.
 - \$2559 to the Knights Of Columbus.
