The diocesan rule is that when young people move away and are involved in or registered in another parish, they are no longer to be listed in SPP Parish. A person or family cannot be registered in two parishes according to the diocese.

Please fill out your new blue form and return by dropping it in the collections on the weekends, or mail to: 625 Lake St, GV. It is very important to have accurate information in our database. This saves the parish money when doing mailings, and updates phone numbers, etc. AND: please include the YEAR of your marriage (if married).
