**“Recent legislative gains, coupled with increasingly pro-life public opinion and data suggesting the annual number of abortions continues to decline, gives the right-to-life movement hope for further success in 2014,”** said National Right to Life President Carol Tobias. **“Pro-lifers remain committed to restoring legal protection to unborn children and helping their mothers.”**

A report issued by National Right to Life yesterday, “The State of Abortion in the United States,” observed that on the basis of the most recent reports from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and the Guttmacher Institute (originally founded as a special research arm of the Planned Parenthood Federation of America), National Right to Life estimates that there have been more than 56 million abortions in America since 1973, the year that the U.S. Supreme Court legalized abortion on demand.

“Pro-abortionists often say that limiting abortion would ‘take us backwards,’ but really, they are the ones who insist that society must remain locked in the Dark Ages of ignorance regarding the capacities of unborn children,” noted Mary Spaulding Balch, J.D., National Right to Life director of state legislation. “Our knowledge about the capacities of the unborn child has increased exponentially since Roe v. Wade, thanks in part of 4-D ultrasound and other sophisticated imaging techniques. The Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act also reflects what medical science has learned about the capacity of unborn children to feel pain.”
