Originally celebrated on the third Sunday after Epiphany, it is now observed on the Sunday between Christmas and January 1. Devotion to the Holy Family became popular after the 16th century. The theme of family, and this feast dedicated to it, is a special importance today in face of challenges to the contemporary family. Many parishes offer families an opportunity to renew their love for each other as part of the liturgy.
