Meditation

"The Father's Works and Our Trust"

Looking at the world today, it is not easy to believe that everywhere Christ is born again, that God looks down on the wreckage and misery—the fiasco, if you like— that we have made of the world, and, seeing us in the midst of it says, ***This is my well-beloved Son!***



But this is so, and however difficult or however insignificant our life may seem to be, it is precious to God as Christ is precious to God. On each one in whom Christ lives, the whole of the infinite love of God is concentrated at every moment. If this were realized, there could be no one who could not fulfill the first condition of rest, which is trust.

If it were not for Christ in us, we would not be able to trust. We are too weak; we could not believe in God's goodness if we had only ourselves to believe with; neither could we love one another if we had only ourselves to love with. We can trust God with Christ's trust in the Father; that is the trust which is our rest.

Our rest in a world that is full of unrest is Christ's trust in his Father; our peace in the world without peace is our surrender, complete as the surrender of the sleeping child to its mother, of the Christ in us, to God who is both Father and Mother.
