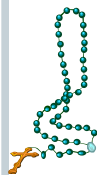

It's time to plan for summer! Idaho Family Camp is Catholic families gathering together in a faith-filled time of Daily Mass, the Sacraments, prayer, and learning, while having "good-ole" outdoor family fun!

Family Camp began in 2007, when five families and one great priest thought it would be a wonderful idea to camp together in the wilderness of Idaho and share "Faith, Family, and Fun".

A 7.8 magnitude earthquake struck Nepal on April 25, just 50 miles northwest of the capital. There have been over 5000 lives lost up to now, but this number is projected to increase.

Bishop Peter F. Christensen has authorized a second collection to be taken in parishes across the Diocese of Boise on the weekend of May 9-10. These funds are to be sent to the Finance Office of the diocese. They will then forward to Catholic Relief Services. Catholic Relief Services have committed to long-term relief efforts. They are providing 10,000 families with emergency shelter materials, blankets, water treatment and hygiene kits.

The month of May is dedicated to The Blessed Virgin Mary. The first 24 days fall within the liturgical season of Easter, which is represented by the liturgical color white—the color of light, a symbol of joy, purity and innocence (absolute or restored). The remainder of the month

(beginning the Monday after Pentecost) is in Ordinary Time which is represented by the liturgical color green. This symbol of hope is the color of the sprouting seed and arouses in the faithful the hope of reaping the eternal harvest of heaven, especially the hope of a glorious resurrection.
