Why Go To Church ?

Comment: It makes no sense to go to church every Sunday. 'I've gone for 30 years now,' he wrote, 'and in that time I have heard something like 3,000 sermons, but for the life of me, I can't remember a single one of them. So, I think I'm wasting my time and the priests are wasting theirs by giving sermons at all.'

Response:

'I've been married for 30 years (no actually 68 years) now. In that time my wife has cooked some 32,000 meals (more like 72,000).
