October- Our Lady of the Rosary  
The Rosary is called the “Psalter of Mary” because its 150 Aves (all fifteen decades, the “Dominican Rosary”) correspond to the number of the Psalms. It is the most well-known and used form of “chaplet,” a devotion said using beads, from a French word meaning crown, or wreath. There are other chaplets, such as those in honor of St. Bridget of Sweden and in honor of the Immaculate Conception.

#### A Bad Dream and a Good Mother

“Our Mother of Perpetual Help” originated in an episode, so says the legend, in young Jesus' life. One day the Christ Child was frightened by the terrifying vision of two angels showing him the instruments of the passion. He runs to his Mother for reassurance, almost losing his sandal on the way. Safely enfolded in her arms, his hands are turned palms down into his Mother's, illustrating that the graces of redemption are in her keeping.
