FATHER JOHN’S WISHES AND THOUGHTS ON OUR MUCH NEEDED ALTAR SERVERS

You may have observed that in the past several years the number of our young people who serve Our Lord at His altar have dwindled. In fact a couple Sundays lately had no servers to assist Father.

Our parish is in need of parents who not only think it is an honor for their children to serve Our Lord and be a part of their parish life, but also encourage their children to do so. When Father had an after Mass meeting with parents and servers, 7 families came, and 9 servers offered to start or continue. We have 220 families registered in our parish.

Father wants a list of all altar servers (and parents) compiled with servers assigned. Then reminders to parents of those servers will be made to have their serving children at the church...**AT LEAST...10 minutes before Mass** to prepare to serve. In future Father will only need 2 servers per each Mass.

If we get enough children wanting to serve, only one weekend a month would be needed or maybe even one weekend every two months, if the Lord blesses us with enough children anxious to serve God. Father John is having on-going training with the servers as he has them at each Mass.

Again, this need to serve Jesus at His altar **must come from the parents** as much as from the children. Just because a student is in high school does not make it **un-cool** to serve our Lord, it remains an honor, whether elementary, high school, college or adult. Is it uncool to be a priest?

Funeral Masses: Father does not want to pull children out of their classes for funeral Masses. If a server has a deceased relative and wants to attend that would be fine, and if they want to serve at that Mass that would be fine. Otherwise, Father does not need them to assist and does not want them missing their classes.
