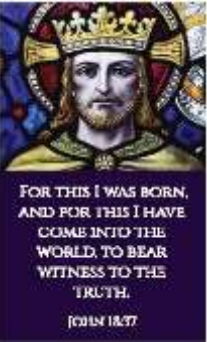

Origin of Feast: In 1925, Pope Pius XI instituted the Feast of Christ the King in the encyclical *Quas Primas* ( from the Latin, “In the First”) to respond to secularism the adoration of ‘idols’ of the earthly world, such as money and fame, above God. Pope Pius XI recognized that secularism would breed hostility against the Church. In fact, during the 20th century, governments in Mexico, Russia, and Europe, infiltrate by secularism, threatened not only the Catholic Church but also civilization itself. *Quas Primas* gave Catholics the hope that while governments may crumble, Christ’s Kingdom, unlike kingdoms of this world, would last forever.
