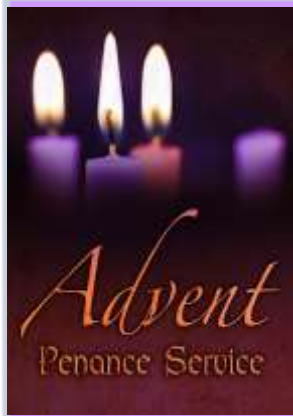

### Altar Servers Ringing the Bells

You may be asking yourself why is there so much ringing of the bells at Mass? The General Instruction of the Roman Missal (200, #150) states ;The bell is first rung at the time of the epiclesis in the Eucharistic Prayer ( when the priest places his hands over the bread & wine to consecrate). This is to alert us to the calling down of the Holy Spirit. The next two times the bells ring is during consecration of the bread & wine. The priest elevates the Sacred Host and then the chalice of the Precious Blood. This is to alert us of transubstantiation has taken place and that the Body & Blood of our Lord is truly present on the altar. The next ring comes after the priest rises from kneeling, we are now awake in the presence of Our Lord. The last bell is rung when the priest drinks the Precious Blood. This tells us we are now invited to either sit, kneel or go up and receive communion.
