Gift Bearers

If the three wise men had said "no" and decided not to follow that star, would we be telling the wondrous story

about the gifts of;gold, frankincense and myrrh presented to the Lamb of God? Perhaps even a more meaningful thought might be of the King of Salem, Melchizedek, a "priest of God Most High" (JB-Gen. 14 vs 19) when he presented the bread and wine to Abram (see Gen: 14 vs 18-20) along with a blessing, should we, as the faithful of the Church, consider any other answer but "yes" when asked to bring the gifts?

Altar Servers

Altar servers help at the altar while the priest celebrates of the liturgy. Altar servers carry the cross or the processional candle. They hold the book when the priest isn't at the altar. They carry the incense and censer or present the bread, wine, and water during the preparation of the gifts. **Altar servers fill a special role in the holy sanctuary, where access is limited to very few people, so it is an honor to participate in the liturgy of the Mass.**



“The altar server has a privileged place in liturgical celebrations . . . Thus you altar servers especially are called to be young friends of Jesus. Strive to deepen and foster this friendship with him.” (Pope John Paul II, August 1, 2001).
