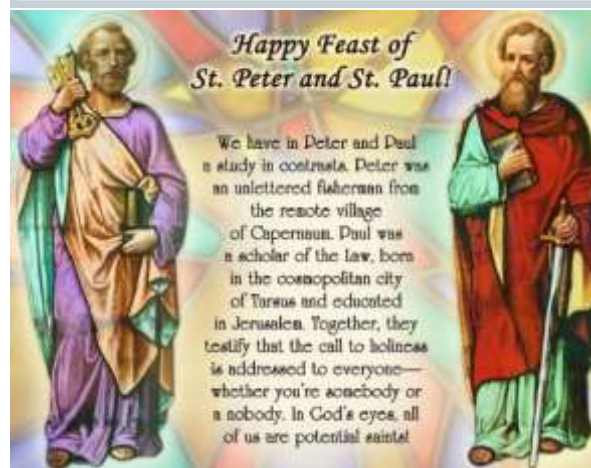

Many adult Catholics who are active in their faith have nonetheless never been confirmed. During this Year of Mercy, Bishop Peter is delegating to pastors and administrators the general faculty to confirm all adult Catholics seeking the Sacrament on the Feast of Christ the King on Sun., November 20. This allows adult Catholics to be confirmed without undergoing the lengthy process more appropriate to catechumens or teens. If you are an adult Catholic who was never confirmed and would like to receive that sacrament, contact your pastor for instructions and join your parish community in celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation with your pastor! Adults who may have impediments to confirmation (e.g., marriage irregularities), should come into the office as soon as possible, so that they have time to address these issues, if able to do so.
