*Bishop Peter officially recognized Summit Academy in
Cottonwood as a Private Catholic School in the Diocese of
Boise effective July 1, 2016. "This grant of recognition and
affiliation is for a two year probationary period. At the end of
the two years, continued recognition and affiliation will be
reviewed. Summit Academy is also granted permission to use
the title "Catholic" in its name, official documents and
marketing materials, should it choose to do so during this
probationary period." What this means is that Summit
Academy is now officially accepted as a Catholic School under
the oversight of the Bishop as are all Catholic Schools in the
Diocese. Summit Academy includes grades 1st-12th.
